- Science, Society, and the Future: This track explores the broader implications of interdisciplinary research and TA for addressing societal challenges, promoting responsible innovation, and shaping the future of science and technology in a rapidly changing world.

Abstracts Submission

We invite submissions of abstracts for presentations within the conference tracks. Abstracts should be no more than **3500 Characters** (with spaces) and clearly articulate the research question(s)/hypothesis, methodology, key findings, and implications of the work. All accepted abstracts will be published in a **Book of Abstracts** that will be published online on the conference website in Open Access form.

- Philosophy of science and technology
- Ethics (research ethics, ethics of new technologies)
- Computational social science

Presentation Format

Accepted abstracts will be presented in dedicated sessions within the respective tracks. The presentation format will be oral presentations, each of 10 minutes + 5 minutes of Q&A.

- Abstracts should adhere to the conference theme and fall within one of the conference tracks.
- Abstracts can be based on research that has been published, is under review, or is a work in progress.
- We encourage researchers from Science, Engineering and Technology, to present the social implications of their research.
